ENTRY CLOSING DATES

ALL ENTRIES AND STABLE REQUESTS CLOSE SEPTEMBER 15TH

HOW TO ENTER

Please ensure that you have read this schedule thoroughly including the Rules and Regulations, Conditions of Entry, Closing Dates and Definitions. Carefully select the classes in which you would like to enter. Please contact Administration if you are unsure of definitions.

1. ENTRIES

Enter online via <u>Event Secretary Events</u>. If you are entering online, you are agreeing to the terms & conditions and the entry is accepted as signed. **No manual entries will be accepted.**

2. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees:

Horse Classes - \$20 per class Pony Club Classes - \$40 (includes all classes) Interschool Showing Classes - \$30 (includes all phases) Interschool Show Jumping Classes - \$50 Donkey Classes - \$10 per class Showjumping - various entry fees, see classes for details

Swabbing fee of \$10.00 per horse (excluding donkey entrants)

Breed registration certificates and current membership cards for breed class entries must be carried at all times and be presented to Judges/Stewards/RGAPS on request. Pending registrations and membership will not be accepted.

SENSORY HAIRS

In line with the new rulings of both Equestrian Australia and the FEI, the clipping/shaving of sensory hairs on horses competing at The Show is prohibited.

3. STABLING

Stabling is allocated based on distance from the Geelong Showgrounds. Stabling requests must be completed and paid for at the time of entry. There are no guarantees that a stable will be available on your chosen day(s). Unallocated stable fees will be refunded after the conclusion of the Show.

4. PASSES

All Exhibitors will receive a Stock Vehicle Pass to enter the Showgrounds which allows the driver to enter free of charge. All other occupants of the vehicle must have pre-purchased special discounted entry tickets when completing entries through event secretary.

Once Entries have closed entry tickets will only be available at normal show entry prices through the Royal Geelong Show website.

Memberships are also available (Adult - \$80 and Junior - \$40 are available via the Geelong show office)

5. CLOSING DATES

Entries strictly close on the advertised closing date/s. Late entries will not be accepted under any circumstances.

6. ENTRY CONFIRMATION & PASSES

Confirmation of classes entered will be emailed from Event Secretary.

HORSE REGULATIONS GENERAL RULES

- Should any conflicting rules arise between the Royal Geelong Agricultural and Pastoral Society Inc (RGAPS) and any other affiliated body, then the rules of this Society will prevail.
- 2. All horses are to be handled only by competent handlers.
- Competitors must obey Marshalling and Stewarding directions otherwise they will be subject to disciplinary action by RGAPS.
- Competitor's age shall be taken as at the first day of the show. Proof of date of birth may be requested for age restricted classes.
- 5. The Horse's age is to be taken from 1st August.
- In these rules, the word "Horse" shall be deemed to describe any equine type or breed including Ponies, Horses, Donkeys etc.
- 7. All perpetual trophies will remain in the RGAPS Administration Office.
- 8. Participants are excluded from claiming against RGAPS in the event of an incident.
- 9. Exhibitors understand that due to diseases such as equine influenza, government bodies may restrict the movement of horses, vehicles, and personnel for a period of time ('standstill'). Exhibitors acknowledge and agree that a standstill is a risk of participation in the event or activity and agree that any costs or expenses incurred by the organising committee for or on behalf of the Exhibitor's animal(s) because of a standstill will be borne by the Exhibitor.
- 10. No Exhibitor may approach the Judge unless approved by the Ring Steward.

LUNGING

- 11. Lunging will only be permitted until 7:30am daily in the Main Arena, outside of the set-up rings.
- 12. Horses must be bitted, and lunge lead attached to the bit.

SAFETY HELMETS

13. Every mounted Rider and Steward within the Geelong Showgrounds must wear a riding helmet that accords with the current Australian Standard. The restraining strap on the riding helmet must be fastened at all times. Riders without appropriate riding helmets shall be ineligible to compete until rectified.

ENTRIES

- 14. No horse is to be nominated by more than one party and must be entered in the name of the owner on the Registration Certificate.
- 15. RGAPS reserves the right to cancel any event if sufficient entries are not received.
- 16. Horses must be entered in one height class only.
- 17. Child riders/handlers must enter in their own age class only.
- 18. Exhibitors must provide registered names of horses and owner.
- Horses entered in Breed classes must be registered and Owners must be financial members of the relevant societies.

CHANGES OF CLASS

- 20. No Class changes from Show Hunter to Open Hack or vice versa will be permitted.
- 21. SUBSTITUTIONS ARE NOT PERMITTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES

- 22. On production of Veterinary or Medical certificates 75% of entry money will be refunded should a horse or rider be certified unfit to compete in any event.
- 23. Scratching's and Veterinary certificates not received within 7 days of the conclusion of the Royal Geelong Show will forfeit any eligible refund.

APPEALS

- 24. Exhibitor appeals will only be considered regarding an Exhibitor's eligibility to compete and will not be accepted for an Exhibit's condition.
- 25. Appeals must be lodged in writing accompanied by a \$100 non-refundable fee.

TRANSFER OF PENALTIES

- 26. The Society reserves the right to refuse entries from Exhibitors who are under suspension by another Society, organisation, body or breed association within Australia.
- 27. The Society may recognise, act upon and enforce any penalty imposed upon any Exhibitor or Exhibit at any time by any other Society, organisation, body or breed association within Australia.

DISTRICT & NOVICE EVENTS

- 28. "Novice" is defined as an Exhibit that has not won a first prize competing singly at any Australian Royal Show at the time of judging.
- 29. All District events are confined to Exhibitors residing within a 60km radius of the Geelong Post Office. The

horse and rider must reside within the 60km radius area for at least 3 months prior to the first day of the Show.

AMATEUR OWNER RIDER CLASSES

- 30. Horse registration must reflect the name of the amateur owner rider as owner. The owner can be the parent and the rider can be an immediate family member, such as a son or daughter.
- 31. Leased horses are eligible as long as the amateur owner rider competitor is reflected as the lessee.
- 32. An amateur owner rider's principle source of income must not be obtained from sponsorship, breaking, training, riding or coaching any horse or rider over the last two years.
- 33. An amateur owner rider must not have sponsorship above \$300 per annum.
- 34. The rider must be 5 years of age or over.
- 35. Entrants in these classes may compete in any other class for which they are eligible.

HORSE MEASUREMENTS

- 36. Only height certificates issued by the RASV, EV and Show Horse Council are duly recognised by RGAPS. All horses must be exhibited in accordance with a current Height Certificate issued by these organisations.
- 37. Exhibits that hold a current Height Certificate must present to the Superintendent's office for height verification. Height verified Exhibits will receive a height stamp on their neck number and will be checked by Stewards in the ring. Where a neck number is not height stamped and a current height certificate cannot be produced the Exhibit must present to be measured prior to class.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

- 38. Excessive use of spurs or whips by an Exhibitor will result in disqualification.
- Exhibitors failing to comply with instructions or regulations of RGAPS will be disciplined as provided for in RGAPS General Regulations.

STALLIONS AND COLTS

- 40. All Stallions and Colts are to be handled or ridden by persons 18 years and over.
- 41. All Stallions and Colts over 1 year must be bitted.
- Stallions and Colts are only eligible to compete in Classes specified with the exception of Showjumping and Donkeys.

STABLING AND YARDING

- 43. Stables will generally be allocated on preference to stallions, mares, geldings and distance to the Showgrounds. There is no guarantee you will be allocated a stable.
- 44. There shall be no stable used or reserved for horses not competing in events.
- 45. Horses must not be removed from stables or yards without the permission of Stewards or the Owners.
- 46. Stables must be fully cleaned out of ALL BEDDING on your departure, or the stable cleaning fee will be debited. A Stable cleaning fee of \$100 applies if stables are not cleaned out completely of all bedding, stables will be inspected on departure.
- Stables will be allocated, where applicable, at a fee of \$20 per day. Stable fees must be included with entries, and allocations will be advised prior to the Royal Geelong Show.
- 48. Stable bond of \$75 (per stable) will apply when entering, stable bond will be returned after the show is completed. All stables must be cleaned out of ALL BEDDING on your departure, if stables are not cleaned out completely of all bedding, (stables will be inspected on departure) bond will not be refunded.
- 49. Fodder and bedding is the responsibility of the Exhibitor, with Shavings or Straw being the only bedding material permitted.
- 50. Stables are to be cleaned out prior to departure; bins will be provided for stable waste.
- 51. Exhibitors must keep their allotted stables in a clean and proper condition throughout the Show, to the satisfaction of the Horse Stewards.
- 52. Stables are allocated to an Exhibit and not the Exhibitor. If the Exhibit allocated the stable is not in attendance or not going to attend, then the stable is forfeited, and the Exhibitor must notify Administration so stables can be reallocated.
- 53. No alterations may be made to stables without permission of the Horse Superintendent.
- 54. There is to be no portable yards erected.
- 55. Electric tape is not permitted under any circumstances.

EXHIBITING

56. Class Clashes- All effort will be made to minimize clashes in events, when entering classes please be aware that due to the complexity of the program there are likely to be clashes between some classes, we are aware of these and every endeavour has been made to eliminate them, where possible. However due to horses having multiple registrations and riders having multiple classes in different rings, it is not possible to eliminate all class clashes, Therefore, where these occur, the

Exhibitor may have to make a choice between one class and the other. Your cooperation will be much appreciated. No Refunds

57. Judging will not be delayed under any circumstances with the exception of Champion classes.

ARENA ACCESS & HORSE MOVEMENT

- All Exhibitors may only access the Arena through the permitted entry of the Eastern Laneway or Gate 1 Showjumping Yards Gate, Southern End Laneway Gate 2.
- 59. Horses MUST only move at a walk on any part of the Showgrounds except when on the Arena or in the exercise yard.
- 60. All horses must tie up and behave in an educated manner. Horses or riders behaving in a manner that could be dangerous to the public will be asked to leave the Showgrounds.
- 61. Horses not entered in an event or being used for riding competitions are not permitted and will be removed from the Showgrounds.
- 62. During warm up or exercise riders are not to enter designated arenas.
- 63. After 7.30am only riders scheduled in first session of the day are permitted on the arena.
- 64. For safety reasons, only exhibitors are permitted on the arena during competition. No chairs other than those provided for judges or stewards are permitted on the arena at any time.

VEHICLE MOVEMENTS

- 65. Livestock vehicles will be refused entry onto the Showgrounds unless they have a Stock Vehicle Pass attached to the windscreen.
- 66. Livestock vehicles upon entry to Showgrounds will be directed to parking areas by Horse Parking Stewards.
- 67. Exhibitors wishing to arrive at the Showgrounds prior to the first day of the Show, must seek permission from Administration prior and only park where directed.
- 68. Any disobedience towards Horse Parking Stewards will result in disqualification of entry or entries.

CAMPING ACCOMMODATION

- 69. A Camping fee of \$20 per night is payable at time of entry, Limited Power sites are available.
- 70. Camping may be restricted to Exhibitors residing outside the district radius (60km).
- 71. Camping is permitted in the horse designated areas only.
- 72. No tents are permitted.

HORSE SWABBING

 Random swabbing of horses will take place under Equestrian Australia Anti-Doping Regulations as per Equestrian Australia National Medication Control rules. A \$10.00 swabbing levy will be payable per Exhibit (excluding Donkeys).

OPEN SHOW HUNTER CLASS GUIDELINES

- 74. Exhibits competing as Show Hunters in either Led or Ridden Classes may not compete in Open Led or Ridden Saddle Classes and Open Saddle Exhibits may not compete in Show Hunter Led or Ridden Classes.
- 75. Type Show Hunters should have more substance than the riding pony type, but still maintain quality.
- 76. Attire Show Hunter Attire is more subdued than that of Open Saddle Classes. There should be no coloured browbands. There should be no multi-coloured hair ribbons or flowers on child riders. Junior riders should not wear top boots.
- 77. Paces Show Hunters are NOT expected to jump but are expected to move freely at all paces. Show Hunters may be expected to, at any time, gallop for the Judge.

2023 ROYAL GEELONG SHOW JUDGES

78. A list of horse judges will be released on the Royal Geelong Show website and Facebook page.

GENERAL RGAPS RULES

ENTRIES

- 1. All Exhibits must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor at the close of entries.
- 2. All entries must be online, on or before the nominated closing date.
- 3. All entry fees as specified in Schedule must be paid at time of entry.
- 4. Exhibitors must give such information regarding their Exhibits as RGAPS may require and submit Statutory Declarations with such information and produce evidence if called upon by RGAPS. In case of non-compliance, the Exhibit may be disqualified, and the prize withheld.
- RGAPS has the right to refuse any entry, refuse any Exhibit entered, the right to compete without giving any reason for same, provided the entrance money is returned.
- 6. Entry fees for withdrawn exhibits will not be refunded.
- 7. An Administration fee of \$20 is to be paid at the time of entries, this fee is non-refundable if the show is cancelled.

JUDGING

- 8. Exhibitors will be required to place Exhibits as directed by the Chief Stewards.
- 9. The decision of the Judge as to the merits of Exhibits shall be final and without appeal.
- Where Special prizes are offered in a Class, the First prize offered by RGAPS will be withdrawn unless otherwise specified.
- 11. RGAPS reserves the right to allot a trophy in place of prize money or vice-versa.
- 12. The Judges' may withhold a prize or award a lesser prize.
- 13. The Judges' decision is final.
- 14. RGAPS will not be held responsible in cases where wrong Class tickets have been given to Exhibitors after judging has commenced. It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to check section tickets with the Prize Schedule prior to the Show.
- 15. The Committee/Stewards reserve the right to modify classes according to the number of entries received.
- 16. Protests awards based on non-compliance with the conditions of the Prize Schedule or the Regulations will be taken into consideration by RGAPS if lodged with the Chief Steward one hour after the Judge has made their award or for Classes where a prize is not awarded by 3:00pm on the day of competition together with \$50 as a guarantee of the bona fide of the protest. The money will be returned if the protest is upheld. RGAPS decision will be final and without further appeal, excluding the dog section, which is affiliated with and controlled by the Rules of Dogs Victoria.

PRIZES

- 17. Perpetual Trophies will remain in the Administration Building, Geelong Showgrounds.
- If, due to unforeseen circumstances sponsorship is not forthcoming for any sponsored class, the prizemoney/prize may not be provided by RGAPS.
- 19. RGAPS reserves the right to use photographs and videos of entries at any time, present or in the future.
- 20. Prizemoney is GST inclusive. If you are registered for GST, the onus is on the Exhibitor to remit GST to the ATO and provide RGAPS with a Tax Invoice.
- 21. SHOW JUMPING -All Prize money will be paid via Electronic Funds Transfer after the conclusion of the show upon verification of results and finalization of any protests and/or drug test results. Exhibitors must supply a valid BSB and Bank account number at the time of submitting entries, should an exhibitor not submit valid Banking details all prize money will be forfeited.
- 22. Any prizes (trophy, voucher, etc.) awarded by RGAPS at any of their competitions and left unclaimed for a period of six months, will be forfeited, and cancelled by the RGAPS Management Council.
- 23. Any infringement of these Regulations may disqualify the Exhibitor from taking a prize. Any dispute as to the construction of these Regulations or the interpretation of the Prize Schedule shall be determined by RGAPS, whose decision is final and without appeal.
- 24. Results will be posted on the Royal Geelong Show website after completion of the show.

ACCESS

- 25. For entry outside of show hours appropriate vehicle passes must be attached to the windscreen of the vehicle, otherwise entry will be refused.
- 26. Gate instructions must be strictly adhered to.
- 27. No Exhibit will be admitted onto the Showgrounds, unless Exhibitor Pass is presented at the gate.
- Security and Show gate personnel have the right to enforce all Regulations regarding gate access to the Geelong Showgrounds
- 29. Implements, machinery and commercial exhibits, livestock and general exhibits must be in their designated areas within the Showgrounds by 8:00am on each morning of the Show.

ANIMALS

- 30. No animals, implements etc. except those entered, will be allowed on the Showgrounds.
- 31. Exhibitors must state as accurately as possible, at time of entry, the date of birth of all stock in classes where age is specified, and in all sheep classes, the time of last shearing.
- 32. Dogs must be registered under the Regulations adopted by Dogs Victoria.
- 33. Water will be provided for stock exhibited, but Exhibitors must provide their own fodder.
- 34. All vehicles bringing livestock Exhibits to the yards must be removed from the Showgrounds after discharging

their loads or placed where directed by the Stewards of the Section.

- 35. Primary Producers who show their animals are required to have Public Liability Insurance.
- 36. If, in the opinion of RGAPS any exhibition of livestock is unsound, either temporary or otherwise, the opinion of a Veterinary Surgeon of RGAPS may be obtained at cost of the exhibitor.
- 37. It is the owner's responsibility to provide security to ensure that their animals are kept safe and secure for the duration of their time at the Geelong Showgrounds.

PROPERTY & BEHAVIOUR

- 38. RGAPS shall not under any circumstances be responsible for any loss or damage of exhibits or displays, all exhibits and displays are accepted solely at the exhibitor's own risk. RGAPS will not be responsible for Exhibits, but every reasonable care will be taken of the same.
- 39. The Royal Geelong Agricultural & Pastoral Society will not be held liable for any injuries that may be suffered by a person or persons taking part on behalf of an Exhibitor. In the event of an incident, RGAPS will appoint attendants to take charge and control all of his/her entries.
- All Exhibitors have a Duty of Care to avoid situations that could lead to injury to themselves or other people. This Duty of Care extends to the prevention of damage to property.
- 41. No Exhibitor shall interfere with the Exhibits in ANY WAY whatsoever during the time the Exhibition is open. Anyone interfering without the permission of the Stewards may be expelled from the Showgrounds.
- 42. No person will be permitted to put any placard or advertisement on pens or grounds without the permission of the Operations Manager. Proprietorship remains that of RGAPS.
- 43. If, in the opinion of the Stewards, the conduct of any Exhibitor or any other person shall be such as to demand such a course, they shall have the power to forfeit any or all prizes such Exhibitors may have won, and may further cause such person or Exhibitor and Exhibit to be removed from the Showgrounds.
- 44. Exhibitors must comply with any reasonable request of RGAPS representatives.
- 45. All areas must be kept clean and tidy with clearly defined and available access and exit routes always. Build-up of combustible waste must be avoided always.

SAFETY

- 46. Care must be taken to minimize trip hazards and obstacles that people may walk into. Avoid laying unprotected cables or pipes on or above paths, walkways or roads.
- 47. Exhibitors must notify the Section/Pavilion Supervisor or Administration immediately of any hazards detected or incidents. Hazards or incidents are any situation that could result or has resulted in:
 - a. the injury, illness or death of any person or animal.
 - b. the damage, destruction or loss of property.
- Emergency information and maps showing Emergency Assembly Points are in the various animal pavilions and buildings. Exhibitors should be familiar with these plans.
- 49. Exhibitors should supply their own Safety Switch (RCD) for installation at each power outlet they use.
- 50. Extension cords must be earthed and all electrical appliances must be earthed or double insulated. Appliances must be in a sound working order.
- 51. The use of double adapters is strictly prohibited. Power boards must be fitted with current overload protection.
- 52. Beverages/Food brought onto the Showgrounds in glass containers is strictly forbidden.
- 53. Radiant electric or gas heaters are prohibited.
- 54. Light sockets must not be used for any other purpose than for lighting.
- 55. No naked flames are permitted.
- 56. Firefighting and other Emergency Equipment must not be removed or used for any other purpose. Missing or unserviceable equipment should be reported to Section/Pavilion Supervisor or Administration immediately.
- 57. All Exhibitor electrical items, including leads, must have a current safety compliance tag.

HOUSEKEEPING

- 58. Smoking is not permitted inside buildings, within 10m of a building entrance, near food sales and eating areas, combustibles, during public performances or while handling hazardous materials.
- 59. Alcohol is not permitted to be brought onto the Geelong Showgrounds.
- 60. Security and Show personnel have the right to enforce all Regulations and control regarding people's behaviour and remove those persons as determined.
- All waste, including liquids, must be disposed of responsibly. Storm drains must not be used for the disposal of waste.
- 62. Media comment about matters involving RGAPS or the Showgrounds is co-ordinated by either the Operations Manager or the President.


